### Be Patient and Kind

*Exercise Christian charity as we all learn to adapt during this time.*

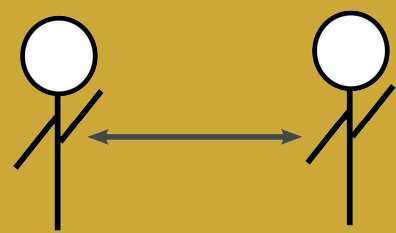


\* *Arrive no more than 30 minutes before Mass and no less than 10 minutes before Mass and please cooperate with instructions upon arrival.*

### Before Mass...

#### Practice Social Distancing

Maintain six feet distance from others who are not members of your household.



#### Wear a Face Mask

Masks must be worn at all times on parish grounds and at Mass, except for reception of Holy Communion.

*Masks must cover nose and mouth.*



#### Sanitize Hands

A Minister of Welcome will offer you hand sanitizer as you are welcomed into the church.

*You may wish to bring your own hand sanitizer as well.*



### During Mass...

#### Minimize Touching

Don't hold hands for Our Father, offer a simple nod or wave for the Sign of Peace, and use foot to adjust kneeler.



#### Follow Instructions for Reception of Holy Communion

Ministers of communion will sanitize hands and wear masks.

- Follow markings on floor to maintain social distance.
- When you get to the minister of Holy Communion, after saying "Amen," lower your mask, and receive and consume the host as normal. Immediately replace your mask.



### At the End of Mass...

#### Remain Seated

Listen for dismissal instructions.



#### Disperse After Dismissal

The Church and Parish Hall must be vacated immediately after Mass so we can sanitize for the next Mass.
